## **Submission Guidelines**

- Do you have an interesting, appealing and/or inspiring story for a workshop or presentation? Please submit your proposal using the template in Word Format that you can download.
- The deadline for submitting your proposal is Saturday Sept 1st 2022.
- TestNet is looking for interesting, non-commercial stories. Commercial presentations, tool promotions and other sessions in which a commercial solution is promoted are not included in the program.
- The members of the events committee each score all entries individually. Their scores are collected and the total score determines whether or not a presentation is selected. In principle, we select one speaker per organization. However, quality is important, so we reserve the right to select multiple speakers from the same company when they achieve the highest scores. Whether or not the speaker's organization is a sponsor does not contribute in any way to the selection of the speaker, nor for presentations.
- The program offers room for workshops (90 minutes or 3 hours) and presentations of 25 or 45 minutes in parallel sessions. In addition to the presentations, the events committee will provide interesting keynotes that matches the theme.
- Please send your submission to <u>sprekers@testnet.org</u> and use the template in Word format.
  Make sure all sections are filled in.
- You will receive a confirmation of your submission, so you know that it has arrived correctly.
- It is possible that the events committee wants to see the slides of the presentation in advance or wants to see a demo of the content of the session.
- Half September 2022 the events committee will compose the program and all entrants will be informed whether or not their presentation is part of the program.
